## Dear Colleagues,

The Ministry of Education, Youth and Information uses this opportunity to advise our stakeholders that the Ministry of Health and Wellness continues its vaccination effort to ensure that all our school staff are vaccinated in all public and private institutions.

Consequently, the Ministry is encouraging all teachers and all eligible support staff to take this opportunity to get vaccinated so that we can safeguard the health of all Jamaicans and work towards the full reopening of the school sector in September 2021.

The Ministry of Health and Wellness has announced a series of vaccination blitz for the period June 9-18, 2021 for persons who are due their second dose of the vaccine. Please note that teachers and eligible support staff are not required to make an appointment to get vaccinated but are being asked to bring a work ID, Government-issued I.D, their TRN as well as the vaccination card which was issued when the first dose of the vaccine was administered.
